- Year 6 achieved above national target set for children achieving EXS and GDS in reading this is a great achievement in particular achieving a significant 39% national target for GDS+. Reading achievements across the school have exceeded national targets in EYFS/KS1 & KS2. Recognition and congratulations should be noted for Mrs. Walden who has led Reading as English lead through the successful implementation of strategies over the last 3 years such as Read, Write, Inc for Phonics, Reading areas in classrooms and organised the timetable to ensure reading is made a priority on a daily basis. Well done to Mrs. Walden and all the reading teachers who have worked hard to ensure the success of phonics and reading across the school throughout the whole of last year.
- Mrs. Walden achieved her NPQLL in 23/24.
- Year 6 significantly achieved above national target for GDS+ in Maths & SPAG. This is also a fantastic achievement.
